Y12 History visit to Cromford Mill, Matlock.

I am writing to inform you of an exciting opportunity that has been planned for Y12 to visit the site of the first factory, Arkwright's Mill. Cromford Mill has been awarded World Heritage Site status to recognise its importance in revolutionising the cotton industry and stimulating Britain's industrial revolution. Students in Y12 have investigated the impact of the industrial revolution on politics, the economy, and people in Britain. By attending this visit, they will be able to take part in a tailor-made workshop and visit both the water-frame and the mill to understand what conditions were really like for workers during this time and understand why Peel's government were so keen to initiate change.

The trip will take place on Thursday the 29th June and students will leave school, by coach at 8.20 and return before the end of the school day. More detailed information is given below.
