### E-Safety Assembly

As part of our Digital Literacy Curriculum we are pleased to be able to offer our students an assembly delivered by staff from the Met Police Digital Intelligence and Investigations Unit for Specialist Crimes Services.

The assemblies will take place on the following dates:

- Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June – Year 9
- Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June – Year 8
- Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June – Year 7

The aim of the assemblies is to promote an awareness of current online dangers, give students the confidence to recognise and report inappropriate online behaviour and know the risks and potential impact for those involved. To communicate this information the police will be discussing the following topics:

**Year 7 and Year 8:** Cyber bullying, sharing private information, what classifies as private information and how to report inappropriate content.

**Year 9:** Cyberstalking, catfishing, online grooming/gangs, sharing/requesting of personal content - photos/videos - laws around this, risks e.g., the impact on your digital footprint, how to seek support and the dangers of accessing the dark web.

Whilst we believe it is important that students at Penistone Grammar School have the knowledge and tools to be able to stay safe and thrive in today's world of technology, we understand that some of these topics may be sensitive for your child. If you feel this may be the case, please discuss this with your child and should they not wish to attend the assembly, ask them to notify a member of staff so that we may provide alternative arrangements and support.
