

KS4 Practice Exams

During weeks 8 & 9, Y11 students will complete their next set of formal practice exams for English. They will complete the following:

- Language Paper 1 (Explorations in creative reading and writing)
- Language Paper 2 (Writer's viewpoints and perspectives)
- Literature Paper 2 (An Inspector Calls, Power & Conflict Poetry, Unseen Poetry)

These exams are vital for students to be able to put their skills into practice in timed conditions, in preparation for the final exams at the end of year 11.

In order to prepare for these exams, we expect students to be revising independently. Home learning this half term has been set with these exams in mind, guiding students towards suitable types of revision. The English department will also be offering after school revision sessions on Tuesdays in weeks 5, 6 and 8 to support students.

What can students do to revise?

- Complete Language past papers
- Students should make sure that they understand the literature texts well – they can't write about a text that they do not know. They will need to know the key characters and themes from each text. They could revise this by creating their own essential knowledge sheets, flash cards and mind maps etc.
- They will need to learn key quotations but, more importantly, they need to know what to say about them.
