Y7 Residential – Hesley Wood Scout Activity Centre

The Y7 residential will take place during the week: Monday 26th June to Friday 30th June over 2 visits (27/06 – 28/06 and 29/06 – 30/06). The year will be split into 2 groups, with one group going on each of the dates outlined above. We send further communication once we have finalised the groups.

Accommodation will be at Hesley Wood Scout Activity Centre in Chapelton. There will be a range of activities available (see the full list below), students will be offered eight activities. The pupils will be away for one night which will be spent either in tents in the grounds or in dormitories in the main building. We cannot guarantee which accommodation your son/daughter will be allocated but expressions of preferred accommodation will be considered.

The total cost of the visit is £80.00, this includes food, accommodation and activities. If you would like your child to take part the consent form must be completed and a non-refundable £10 deposit paid by **Friday 10th February 2022**.

Students can be dropped off at 10am at the campsite on the first day and collected at 4.30pm on the second day. Students who require a bus transfer will be expected to be in school at usual time and will return to school at approximately 5pm. There will be an additional charge of between £10 and £20 for any students who require transport to and from the campsite. We will confirm the exact price once we know the number of students who require transport.

Please indicate if your child needs a place on the bus on the consent form. We cannot guarantee a place on the bus after the 10 February.
