Behaviour

Students are expected to behave in an exemplary manner as ambassadors of our school and conduct themselves appropriately. For the safety of everyone involved, students will need to follow instructions from both the staff accompanying the students and the Escape Hunt team. Should the conduct of your child in the lead up to, or during the visit, be deemed either unacceptable or likely to put the health, wellbeing, safety and/or enjoyment of other students on the trip at risk, the Principal reserves the right to withdraw your child's place from the visit, or they may be returned home prior to the end of the visit.

All school policies will be in place during the visit and our expectations for behaviour remain the same. There will be no unsupervised time, however students will be able to leave the school group in pairs at specific times for comfort breaks. Students are permitted to take mobile phones on the trip and they may wish to listen to music on the train through earphones, for example. However, students are not permitted to take photographs of other students or of any incidents that may occur.

Students do not need to wear school uniform on this day, please dress for the weather as we will be walking to and from the train station in Penistone and Sheffield. There is a chance the clothing may become grubby, so please avoid wearing white or expensive garments. For footwear, please wear closed-toe boots/trainers with a good grip.

Consent

Please log on to Parentpay to provide consent and your friend's name. On giving consent you are agreeing to your child taking part in the above activity and have read the information provided agreeing to his/her participation in the activities described. You are also agreeing to your child receiving any emergency medical treatment that may be deemed necessary. If there are any exceptions to this, please provide us with the necessary information in writing. We need permission for photos for school use, medical information and parental consent.

Please note it is essential you provide consent via Parentpay if consent is not received NAME will not be able to attend the trip.
