#### **Uniform / Appropriate Clothing**

As the trip departs from Penistone Grammar School after the school day, students are not expected to wear school uniform. However, all clothing should still be appropriate including appropriate for weather. All students will be reminded that they are representing the school and as such, high standards will be upheld.



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### Mobile Phones

Students are encouraged to bring a mobile phone with them to contact parents/carers when we are returning to Penistone Grammar School. We will expect parents to pick up students, even those students who usually walk home after school. Please note, the school cannot be held responsible in cases of damage or loss to phones. All phones and smart devices must be switched off during the performance.

### Drinks and Snacks

Students are allowed to bring their own snacks and drinks into the theatre; however, we expect students to be quiet and respectful to other audience members and the actors. Loud, rustling snacks or fizzy drinks are not recommended. **Nuts are not allowed on the trip, including peanut butter and in chocolate.**

### Behaviour

Students are expected to behave in an exemplary manner as ambassadors of the school. Students will need to follow instructions from staff. Should the conduct of a student in the lead up to, or during the visit, be deemed either unacceptable or likely to put the health, wellbeing, safety and/or enjoyment of other students on the trip at risk, the Principal reserves the right to withdraw that student's place from the visit, or they may be returned home prior to the end of the visit. All school policies will be in place during the visit. Road safety will be taken very seriously.

### Written Work

As stated above, students will be completing written work based upon what we see in the theatre. They will need to bring their Drama books and a pen/pencil to make notes whilst watching.

### Payment and Consent

Please provide consent via parent pay. On giving consent, you are agreeing to your child taking part in the above activity and have read the information provided agreeing to his/her participation in the activities described. You are also agreeing to your child receiving any emergency medical treatment that may be deemed necessary and to pick your child up from school upon our return. If there are any exceptions to this, please provide us with the necessary information in writing. We need permission for photos for school use, medical information and parent consent. The trip is non-refundable.
