We are pleased to inform you of a proposed educational trip for our Year 10 and Year 11 Sociology students to **Shrewsbury Prison** on **Monday 5 January 2026**.

This visit includes the **KS4 Educational Package**, designed to support key areas of the **WJEC GCSE Sociology** course, particularly the **Crime and Deviance** unit, which both year groups are currently studying. Students will explore topics such as punishment, the role of prisons, and the criminal justice system in a real-world setting—bringing classroom theory to life and helping to deepen understanding ahead of their exams.
