GCSE Results Day Arrangements

Dear Student and Parent/Carer

Following the letter which was sent out on 11th May 2023, we are writing to remind you of some key points and also provide information about post results services available on GCSE results day.

GCSE results will be ready for collection on **Thursday 24th August between 9am and 11.00am** from the school sports hall. Please line up at the fire doors nearest to the bus bay which will be sign posted. Results will not be distributed to any student before 9am so please do not arrive too early. If you will not be here to collect them in person there are other options available, the document attached to this letter explains this clearly. If you require any support around exam results collection, please email the exams team as soon as possible exams@penistone-gs.uk Please be reminded that exam results **will not be given over the telephone or via email**.

Exam boards offer a range of post results services including a review of marking. On results day the school will carefully review the results of all students and subjects to identify any potential upgrades if students are close to the next grade boundary. The decision to request a review will be taken by Mr Crook and the Curriculum Subject Leader. We have a set criterion which we apply to this process, and you will be informed if we intend to do this, you will be asked to sign a consent form at the time of collecting your exam results so we have this in place should we require it. Whatever the outcome of the review of marking, you will be informed as soon as possible.

Where the criterion is not met to apply for a review of marking, you have the right to request this. However, you will have to fund this before the application is processed, information on applications, deadlines and costs will be available to you on results day if requested. Please be aware that following a review of marking, the final grade stands and there is a risk that a grade can **go down as well as up**.

On the evening of Wednesday 20th December, we will be hosting our annual Year 11 Awards events where GCSE certificates and prizes will be distributed to students. Parents/carers will also be invited to this event. Please keep the date free in your diary.

Finally, can we wish you a very restful and happy summer. We look forward to seeing you on results day.
