Your child will return with an extensive revision booklet with hundreds of exam questions, some of which will have been completed on the weekend, but most will be left to complete as independent revision.

The weekend will be intensive and hard work, so as a little respite on Saturday afternoon, we'll be walking down the river path into York where pupils can have 3 hours to themselves, exploring the city as they please.

It is hoped that every pupil will wish to attend this weekend. We are confident in the importance and effectiveness of this trip; we have run it successfully, with excellent feedback, for many years. It is also the perfect time to kick start final revision schedules!
