A-Troop - Basic Training Weekend

A-Troop will take part in a foundational training experience, learning essential cadet skills such as:

- Cooking in the field
- Camouflage and concealment
- Sleeping under a military basha

Cadets will also be issued their full CCF kit and uniform, returning home on Sunday fully equipped.

Timings: Friday 1500hrs – Sunday 1200hrs

Important: This is a key weekend for A-Troop. Missing it may delay a cadet's progress, as they will miss both their uniform issue and the core skills that underpin our CCF programme.

B-Troop – Navigation Weekend

B-Troop will undertake a navigation challenge, covering over 20km in small groups.

They'll be based at school in tents but will spend most of the weekend navigating outdoors.

This is excellent preparation for the Bronze DofE expedition later in the year.

C-Troop – Barnslian Patrol Competition

For the first time, C-Troop will compete against other cadet units from Barnsley at **CMADE Outdoors**, **Silkstone**.

Events include:

The goal: to bring home the inaugural **Barnslian Patrol Trophy!**

Cadets will be based at school and travel to Silkstone on Saturday.
