A furious and funny new play that explores whether teenage girls will save the world and asks if they should have to.

I am pleased to offer this trip to our students, especially those just starting their Drama GCSE. As you know students get so much from seeing professionals in terms of role modelling what excellence looks like, inspiration, staging and design, and exam content. GCSE students are advised to see as much live theatre as they can and will need to write notes and reflect on how they can make theatre, improve performance and analyse work as a result. Please check with your child and that you are happy with this play's content, there are some tricky themes (growing up, gender, protest, anti-social behaviour, anxiety, uncomfortable emotions) and might be swearing. The playwright is from Doncaster and won the Radius playwriting prize in 2018. We think it will be an exciting show!
