The trip will introduce students to the wide range of job opportunities in health and social care, from clinical to non-clinical roles including blood transfusion, nursing, comms and marketing, administration, facilities, construction, ambulance service, pharmacy plus lots more.

Students will follow a simulated patient's journey before visiting the careers marketplace with representation from local health and care providers from Barnsley including staff members from Barnsley Hospital, South, West Yorkshire NHS Foundation Trust, South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board, Barnsley's Primary Care Network, Barnsley Council and further and higher education providers.

Students will need to wear school uniform and will need planners, books etc for afternoon lessons.
