As stated in the previous letter, the entire residential will take place at **Hesley Wood Scout Activity Centre** in **Chapeltown**. There will be a range of activities, and students will take part in eight from the list. The students will be away for one night which will be spent either in tents in the grounds or in dormitories located in the main buildings. We cannot guarantee which accommodation your child will be allocated but expressions of preferred accommodation will be considered.

Students can be dropped off at 10:00 at the centre on the first day and collected at 16:30 on the second day.

Students who require a bus transfer will be expected to be in school at usual time and will return to school at approximately 17:00 the following day. There will be an additional charge of between £10 and £20 for any students who require transport to and from Hesley Wood. We will confirm the exact price once we know the number of students who require transport.
