Information for Cadets Remembrance Parades

We are delighted to have 100+ cadets taking part both our schools remembrance parade on Friday 08th November and our annual parade through Penistone town Centre to St John's church on Sunday 10th November. Below you find information for both parades, if you wish to attend as a parent / guardian to watch you are more than welcome. You will find all information and times below:

Friday 8 November: For School's parade we ask that parents do not park in the bus bays, and are in position by the school's war memorial for 10:30am ready for all of our cadets to march in at 10:45am. All cadets will be on parade for this and our wreath layer Freddie Burgess will be laying our wreath on behalf of our unit. There is no cost for this event but cadets must wear full uniform *including smock* to be able to parade. A number of our cadets will also lay the names of those PGS students who lost their lives during the wars.

Sunday 10 November: This our annual remembrance parade we will march through our local town to St John's church.

We ask that any of our NCO's (L/Cpls/Cpls/Sgts/S/Sgts) meet at the Royal British Leigion in Penistone no later than 09:45.

For cadets that do not yet hold a rank we ask that they meet us at Tesco park by the Garages at 10:15. Cadets must be in full uniform (ironed + polished boots) including a smock. For both parades black gloves may be worn. We will march into the square by the church and parents/carers/friends and family are more than welcome to both watch and then join us at the legion afterwards for refreshments (pop + crisps are provided FOC by the legion).

Marching in a parade can be a tiring event so it is vital that all cadets have a good breakfast and are sufficiently hydrated before the event, most soldiers who faint on parade are dehydrated and suffer a sudden drop in blood sugar so please ensure your cadet has eaten and had a drink before the parade.

Lunch is not provided for the Penistone parade as we will be dismissed before lunchtime, pop and crisps will be served FOC after the parade at the legion.
