### **A Level results day arrangements 2026**

Dear Student and Parent/Carer

We are writing to remind you of some key points and also provide information about post results services available on A Level results day.

A Level results will be ready for collection on **Thursday 13th August between 8am and 10.00am** from the Post 16 centre. Please wait at the entrance for a member of staff to give you access. Results will not be distributed to any student before 8am so please do not arrive too early. If you will not be here to collect the results in person there are other options available, the document attached to this letter explains this clearly. If you require any support around exam results collection, please email Miss Moorhouse as soon as possible [nmoorhouse@penistone-gs.uk](mailto:nmoorhouse@penistone-gs.uk) Please be reminded that exam results **will not be given over the telephone or via email.**

Exam boards offer a range of post results services including a review of marking and access to scripts. On results day the school will carefully review the results of all students and subjects to identify any potential upgrades if students are close to the next grade boundary usually within 2/3 marks. The decision to request a review will be taken by Mr Crook, Mr Stevens and the Curriculum Subject Leader. We have a set criterion which we apply to this process, and you will be informed if we intend to do this, you will be asked to sign a consent form at the time of collecting your exam results so we have this in place should we require it. Whatever the outcome of the review of marking, you will be informed as soon as possible.

Where the criterion is not met to apply for a review of marking, you have the right to request this. However, you will have to fund this before the application is processed. Information on applications, deadlines and costs will be available to you on results day if requested. Please be aware that following a review of marking, the final grade stands and there is a risk that a grade can **go down as well as up.**

Finally, can we wish you a very restful and happy summer. We look forward to seeing you on results day.

A Level Examination results will be available for collection, **in person**, on **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August** between **8.00am – 10.00am**. The results distribution will take place in the Post 16 center, please line up at the entrance for a member of staff to give you access.

If you are unable to collect your results from school the following alternative arrangements are available to you:

**1. By Post - If you want results to be posted home or to a different address.**

An envelope including the correct address and postage should be delivered to school reception **no later than Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July**. Results will be posted on the morning of 14<sup>th</sup> August, depending on the postage provided, they will be received after this date.

**2. By Nominee - If you wish to have your results collected by a person nominated by you.**

You must complete the attached nomination form and email it to [nmoorhouse@penistone-gs.uk](mailto:nmoorhouse@penistone-gs.uk) or deliver it to the school reception no later than **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July**. The nominee is required to bring photographic identification (such as a Driving License or Passport) when collecting your results. Examination results will **NOT** be given to any person without written consent and identification.

The exams office will also be open on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> August, between the hours of 8.00am and 4.00pm for any further collection of results. The exams office will then re-open for the new term in September.
