The HeartSpace enrichment programme aims to provide all students with opportunities to develop important skills that will support them throughout their school life, as well as fostering the skills needed to prepare them for everyday life after school. Within HeartSpace itself students take part in horticulture through planting, growing, and creating in our very own garden and greenhouse, alongside our **Experiential and Outdoor Learning Lead**.
